

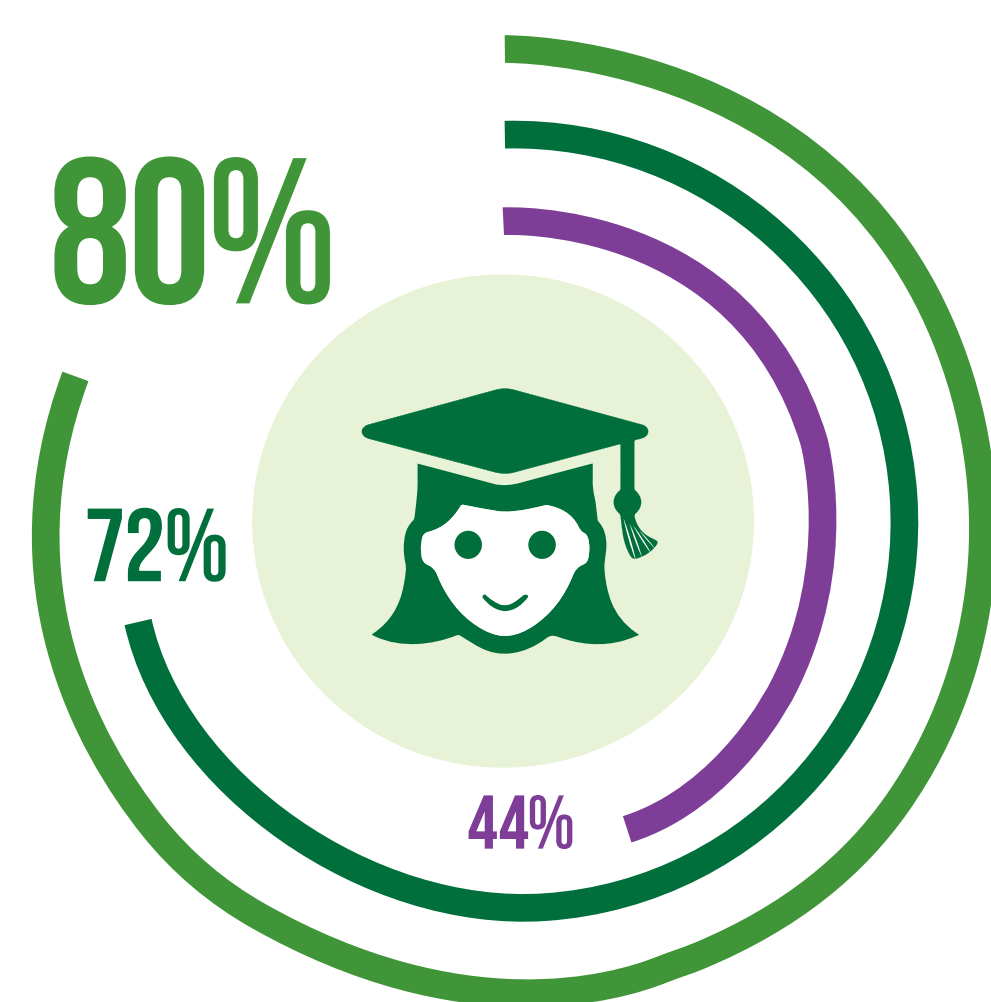

Nearly **80%** of girls' school students report most of their classes **challenge them to achieve their full academic potential** compared to 72% of girls at coed independent and 44% at coed public schools.

BUILDS SELF-CONFIDENCE

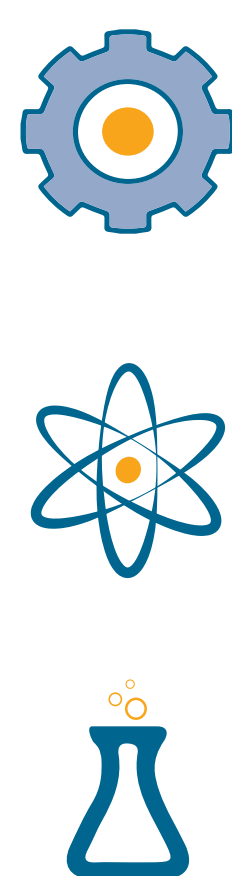
AT GIRLS' SCHOOLS, A GIRL OCCUPIES EVERY ROLE

A **majority** of girls' school grads report **higher self-confidence** over their coed peers.



SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY, ENGINEERING, AND MATH (STEM)

GIRLS' SCHOOLS FOSTER INTERESTS IN UNDERREPRESENTED STEM SUBJECTS



6X MORE LIKELY INTERESTED IN STEM

Girls' school grads are **6 times more likely** to consider **majoring in math, science, and technology** compared to girls who attend coed schools.

of students at all-girls' schools expect to earn a graduate or **professional degree**.

GIRLS' SCHOOLS EMPOWER STUDENTS TO BECOME BOLD LEADERS

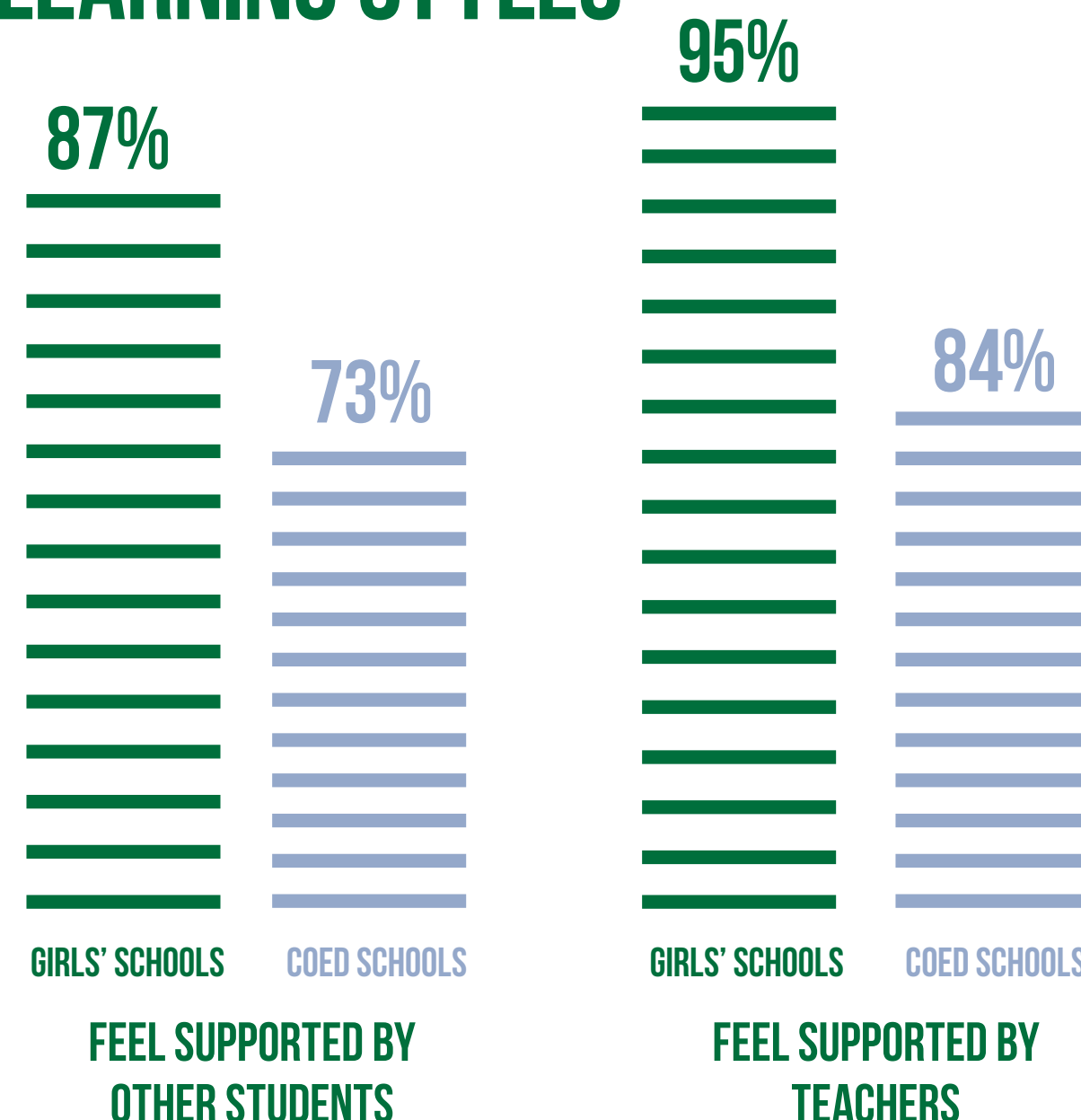
